“Top Ten” Scholarship

Eligibility Requirements

- There is no minimum GPA requirement to apply.
- Applicant must be or will be a high school graduate in Hamilton, Parke, or Wabash County in the 2023-2024 school year.
- Applicant must be enrolled or attending college in the 2024-2025 school year.
- Applicant must follow all directions listed below to be considered.

The Indiana Estate & Elder Law Historical Figure Scholarship will be awarded to the applicant who, in the judgment of the selection committee, appears most deserving based on the scholarship criteria. **One \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to a student from any of the following counties: Hamilton, Parke, and Wabash.**

1. Applicant must complete the attached scholarship application.
2. Applicant must submit one (1) personal recommendation from an instructor, counselor, club advisor, coach, church leader, or employer. Such personal recommendation must be in an enclosed envelope.
3. Applicant must submit one (1) response totaling 600-800 words to the following essay question in APA style. The response should be in Arial font, double-spaced, and in 12 pt. font:

Give us your “top ten” list. Make a top ten list about anything of your choosing. Be creative!

1. The applicant packet consisting of the scholarship application, essay, personal recommendation, and a signed copy of the release on page three (3) are all due to Indiana Estate & Elder Law (10412 Allisonville Road, Ste. 113, Fishers, IN 46038) by Friday, March 15, 2024, at 4:30 pm, in a 9” x 12” envelope. Please do not fold the application packet.
2. Scholarship recipients will be asked to provide a photograph to be added to the company website and to share with media. Depending on availability, an employee of Indiana Estate & Elder Law may be present at their school’s award ceremony.
